- The FY22-23 award amounts as illustrated in Exhibit A must be obligated by June 30, 2023 and expended by September 30, 2023.
- Reestablish Budget for Unliquidated Obligations (Encumbered Balance as of 6/30/22 of FY21-22 Final Award) in FY23-24 through OBMS by July 15, 2023, using fund code 24175 (secondary institutions) or fund code 24178 (postsecondary institutions) and revenue object code 44500.
- Pursuant to NMSA 6-5-3, the appropriate fund shall be encumbered prior to the issuance of vouchers or purchase orders or the engagement of contracts.

Indirect Cost Rate

As required by 2 C.F.R. § 200.332(a) (1) (xiv), PED recognizes the indirect cost rate between PED and public school districts and state charter schools as calculated by PED and located on the PED website: <u>https://webnew.ped.state.nm.us/bureaus/administrative-services/accounting/</u> Carl Perkins Grant allows up to a maximum of 5% for indirect costs.

Access to Records and Financial Statements
